Previous minutes read out from the meeting held at the Norman Hotel Sunday 28th September 2013

Treasurers Report read out:

General Items:

Lowline Journal - The 2014 Journal is out now.

New beef brochure (reprinted old brochure)

Testimonial sheets on first calving need to be sent out to all members, most had not seen it before.

New Qld Promotional groups. The members present suggested that it was now not constitutional to break Qld into two groups and that it would need constitutional change to allow two groups to operate. However it is possible to have sub groups under the Qld Lowline Plus Group. If a Central Qld group wants to operate they will need to form a group and approach Lowline Plus for support.

Facebook page for chat room. Members present agreed that this needs to be a nationally funded and developed project, mainly due to the wide internet coverage.

Lowline Youth. All agree to support the National scheme and to continue the youth exchange with New Zealand. Lowline Plus to apply for subsidy from ALCA

- Increase sponsorship at shows (i.e.; EKKA to \$200). Rejected by the members present. It may be possible for students to look after animals if breeders wish to enter animals for both the EKKA and Beef 2015. The concept is that the breeder enters the animals, freights them to the site, supplies the feed and then organises the animals return to their stud. The students will maintain the animals during the week and show the animals for the breeder. Cattle in on Monday 11th August out on Sunday 17th August. Most breeders avoid shows because of the time involvement. Using students to manage the animals for the majority of the time allows the breeder to minimise their time lost.
- It was noted that it is possible to buy back your own steers from the EKKA and receive the carcass point scoring details
- Bundaberg Agro trend 9-10 May REJECTED
- Farmfest Toowoomba 3-5 June REJECTED
- Agro Emerald 8-10 July REJECTED
- Farm Fantastic Caboolture 22-24 August. Possible (need further information)
- Agshow Toowoomba 2-4 September. Possible involvement with running the hoof and Hook section for school students. Use this event for youth selection for New Zealand prize. Ausline is willing to share costs and coordination, with possible extension to all participants within the hoof and Hook competition.
- Small Breed Field Day. Cancelled for 2014
- Beef 4-9 May 2015 Rockhampton (possible student help from both local and other schools). Several schools wish to attend without cattle, but are enthusiastic about helping studs with preparation and showing. Low-line Plus wishes to support members attending Beef 2015, preferably with a freight subsidy (approx. \$2000). The members present also support a Lowline stand. (approx. \$1000). ALCA to be approached for support from the promotional pool.

Lowline Steer marketing. Col gave a quick rundown on the potential market of 5 beasts per month to a Sunshine Coast butcher. The challenging task is encouraging breeders to think ahead and provide a delivery schedule. This puts a commercial challenge onto our hobby farmer base.
